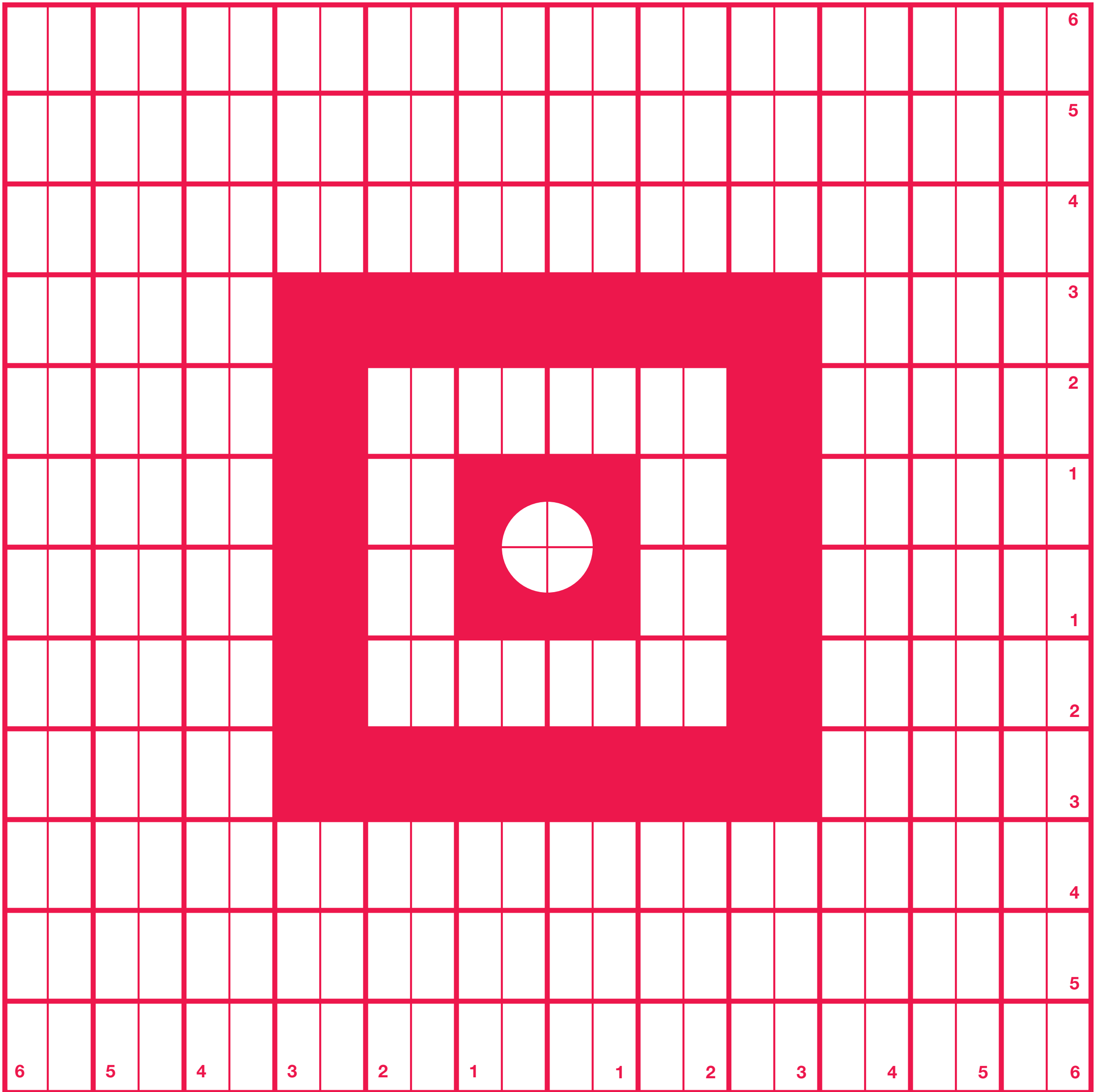

## 10 COMMANDMENTS OF SHOOTING SAFETY

1. **Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded firearm.**
2. **Watch that muzzle!** Be able to control the direction of the muzzle even if you should stumble.
3. **Be sure of your target and beyond before you pull the trigger.** Know identifying features of the game you hunt.
4. **Be sure that the barrel and action are clear of obstructions** and that you have only ammunition of the proper size for the firearm you are carrying.
5. **Unload firearms when not in use.** Take down or have actions open. Firearms should be carried in cases to and from the shooting area.
6. **Never point a firearm at anything you do not want to shoot.** Avoid all horseplay with a firearm.
7. **Never climb a fence or tree or jump a ditch with a loaded firearm.** Never pull a firearm toward you by the muzzle.
8. **Never shoot a bullet at a flat, hard surface or water.** During target practice be sure your backstop is adequate.
9. **Store firearms and ammunition separately** beyond the reach of children and careless adults.
10. **Avoid alcoholic beverages or other mood altering drugs before and during shooting.**
